ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants who are not beyond the compulsory school age must have earned a high school diploma or a general equivalency diploma.

Course Length:

160 Hours



Course Description

This course prepares students to perform the fundamental skills of the nurse aid. The Nursing Assistant Certification course offer students 160 hours of instruction and hands-on experience in basic nursing skills, personal care skills, and safety and emergency care issues. More than half of the program hours spent in clinical setting, where students have an opportunity to apply their course knowledge in a practical setting.

CLINICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Physical Exam (Taken within the last 3 months)
- Updated TB Test / PPD Skin Test (Purified Protein Derivative) (Taken within the last 3 months)
- Hepatitis B Vaccine
- Drug Screen Test (Taken within the last 30 days before the clinical schedule)
- Police & Court Clearance
